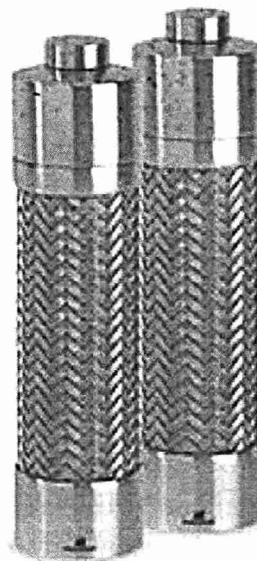
Salt 'n Pepper

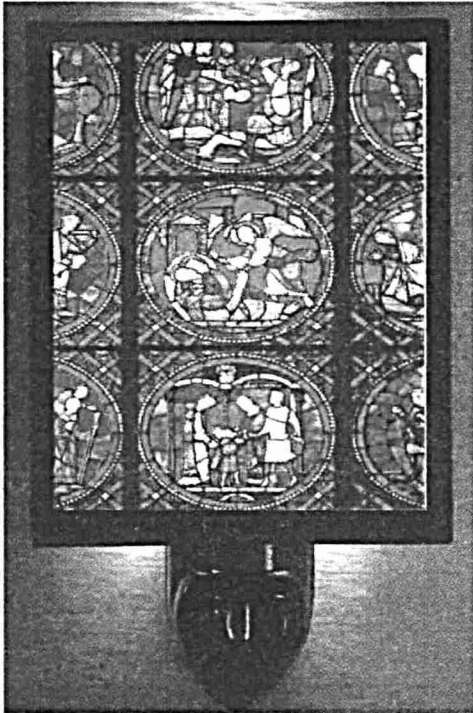

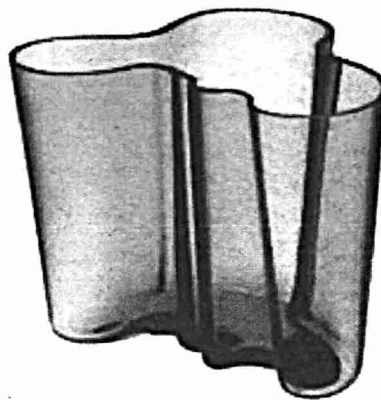
