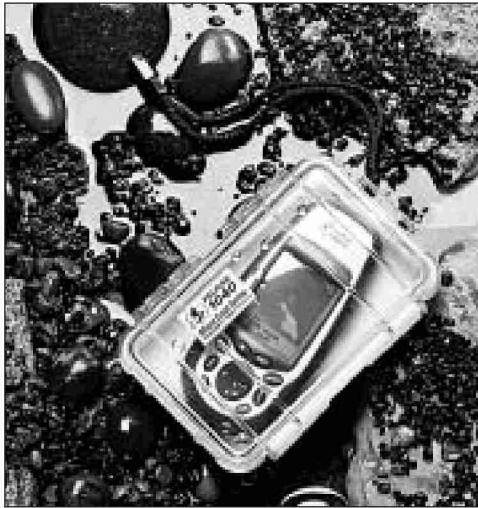

**Pelican Micro Cases** come in handy. The polycarbonate cases are available in a variety of sizes (from about 3 by 5 inches to about 5 by 9 inches, each 2 to 3 inches thick), are virtually crush-proof (the company claims you can run over them with a 5,000-ton truck, but I did not have one available for testing) and although not technically listed as waterproof, the cases seem to be able to withstand a brief bit of submersion (as proven by my submerging them in a bathtub full of water to no ill effect). They are available to fit cellphones, mp3 players, pagers, GPS units, sunglasses, or anything else

you might have bumping around in a truck, boat, camping, or in a backpack or travel case that could get wet or banged up. The cases come with a rubber liner that acts as an O-ring, and you can purchase a foam insert to custom-fit your electronics so that they will sit immobilized inside the case.
